



Raincoat Contemporary Art Space - Submission Form (May 2026)

If you would like to make submission to, or have already been approached by Raincoat to be an exhibitor, this form needs to be completed and signed by you, so that we all know what the conditions and terms of reference are. By exhibiting with us, you remain free to exhibit anywhere you wish .. (and of course to resubmit with us if you would like to!)

Raincoat promises a user-friendly exhibition opportunity to any who are selected for public exhibition but, even so, we need to set out some minimal costs and some guidelines :

Raincoat is not a “Commercial Gallery”, in that it does not seek to make big profits from work chosen for exhibition. **Raincoat is also not an “ARI”** and, while we sincerely welcome input from artists, the Gallery cannot give them control of their work when it is being exhibited. (Our Lease Agreement does not allow us to “hire out” or “sub-lease” any part of the space to others.) Because our intention is also to offer a variety of art work for visitors to experience, we do not accept solo shows which would take up the entire space.

- Exhibitions will run for four weeks, with one or more weeks closed for preparation and rearrangement between shows.
- Applicants will need to fill in the form (below) with a few personal details and examples of their work. Upon acceptance of a proposal, a more personalised and detailed “Acceptance” form will be sent.
- The cost for a Solo Exhibition in ONE of the spaces (for four weeks) is \$180.
- The cost for exhibiting fewer works (also for four weeks) will be \$30 per piece of artwork (capped at \$100 if four or more works are accepted) - **costs to be paid at the time of signed acceptance for a spot.** (i.e. on the “Acceptance” form).
- **Selection, Curation and Sales will all be managed by Raincoat.** We take 20% commission on sales. (To cover this, we suggest that you calculate what you would like to receive and **add 25%** ..)
- Exhibition Openings will take place on Saturday Mornings, starting at 10am and staying open until 4pm.
- After that, weekly viewing times will be on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, from 10am unto 2pm.
- The Gallery will be monitored during these times by the Gallery owners (although artists will be welcome to organise other access times to suit them).
- We are confident that the Gallery is secure as it has an added strong-fire-proof-door and is responsibly monitored at all times when open. We must inform you, though, that we have **Public Liability Insurance ONLY** and **cannot take any responsibility for the loss or damage of your work** while it is in our care. If this is of concern to you, please do consider taking out Personal Insurance Cover.
